



## Course in Automated External Defibrillation 22101VIC

This accredited course provides participants with the essential skill and knowledge required to perform Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED). It is relevant for people working in the education, aged care, sport, outdoor recreation, hospitality, industry enterprises as well as in the home or other environments. It is also suited to designated first aid officers who have access to a defibrillator.

The Australian Resuscitation Council recommends a CPR update every 12 months.

### Course Content

- **The importance of early defibrillation**
- **First aider's responsibilities**
- **Infection control**
- **Operating an AED**
  - The skills required to safely perform defibrillation
- **CPR**

- **Combining CPR and defibrillation**

### Qualification

- A Statement of Attainment will be issued to all successful applicants.
- The qualification will be valid for 1 year

### Duration

4 hours face –to-face training.

### Prerequisites

There are no prerequisite units. Participants should have numeracy and literacy skills equivalent to level 2 of the National Reporting System.

### Assessment methods

Formative assessment throughout the course.

This includes the demonstration of practical skills and answering of written and oral questions.
