This course was designed for the management of asthma emergencies rather than the day-to-day treatment of asthma. It suits parents, carers, school staff and individuals with an interest in asthma.

Course Content

- Prepare for an asthma episode within the workplace context.
 - Developing risk management strategies for an asthma emergency
 - Understanding What Asthma is
 - Understanding what Triggers Asthma
- Assess the emergency situation Developing risk management strategies for an asthma emergency
 - Assess severity of asthma situations
- Apply the appropriate first aid procedures for an asthma episode.
 - First Aid Management of a Severe Asthma Attack
 - Recognising Asthma Medications and how to use them
- Communicate details of emergency asthma incidents.
- Evaluate responses to asthma emergencies.

You will also:

- Gain the Skills to write an Asthma Policy at your workplace
- Learn Safe Storage, Cleaning and Handling of the Asthma Equipment

Qualification

- A nationally recognised statement of attainment will be issued to all successful applicants, valid for 3 years

Duration

4 hours face-to-face training

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisite units. Participants should have numeracy and literacy skills equivalent to level 2 of the National reporting System

Assessment methods

Progressive assessment throughout the course.

Includes the demonstration of practical skills and answering of written/oral questions.
