



## **22575VIC- Course in Basic Oxygen Administration for First Aid**

**INC: VU23077 Apply First Aid Oxygen Therapy and Oxygen Resuscitation**

**(HLTAID009 Provide CPR can be delivered at the same time)**

This Accredited Course will give first aid officers the skills and knowledge to be able to Administer Basic Oxygen Therapy. The target group is any person who is required to recognise and respond to situations that require application of oxygen therapy and/or oxygen resuscitation as appropriate until the arrival of medical assistance.

### **Course Content:**

- Benefits of Oxygen Therapy
- Safety & recognition of oxygen cylinders.
- Administration of Oxygen Therapy
- Oxygen resuscitation – Oxygen Powered resuscitator
- CPR (additional)

### **This course excludes the:**

- Use of bag-valve-mask, manually triggered resuscitators and closed-circuit oxygen units
- Administration of oxygen in non-first aid situations

### **Qualification**

Students of the 22575VIC Course in Basic Oxygen Administration for First Aid will be able to recognise and respond to emergency situations that require the application of oxygen therapy or oxygen resuscitation, as appropriate, until the arrival of medical assistance. This course should be renewed every 12 months. CPR should be updated annually as per ARC guidelines.

A nationally recognised statement of attainment will be issued to all successful applicants.

### **Duration**

4 hours Face-face training

### **Assessment Methods**

Progressive assessments throughout the course.

Theory and practical assessed in class

### **Prerequisites**

There are no prerequisites units. Participants should have numeracy and literacy skills equivalent to level 2 of the National Reporting System.
